**Device:** All students must have a laptop computer with a physical keyboard, a 6-hour battery, an 11" screen, and the ability to run the full version of the Google Chrome web browser. Protective case is recommended.

**Lock** for locker (optional) – combination must be given to the office.

**Classroom Supplies** – Year supply of pens, pencils, index cards, highlighters, colored pencils, filler paper

**Agenda** – Provided on the first day of school. You do not need to purchase your own.

**Accounting I and II:** Inexpensive basic calculator

**Algebra 1 CP1 & CP2:** 1" 3-ring binder, two 1-subject spiral notebooks with holes, graphing calculator\*

**Algebra 2 CP1:** 1" 3-ring binder with dividers and two 1-subject spiral bound notebooks with holes, graphing calculator\*

**Algebra 2 CP2:** 2 spiral notebooks with holes, 3-ring binder with dividers, graphing calculator\*

**Anatomy:** 1 spiral notebook and a 3-ring binder

**AP Art & Painting:** Set of paintbrushes, drawing pencils, sketchbook (minimum size 5"x8")

**AP Music Theory:** 3-ring binder with dividers, lined filler paper, staff paper

**Art Classes (All):**

Set of graphite pencils (at least 2H to 6B)

White Mars eraser

Sketchbook, minimum size 5"x8"

**English (All):** 3-ring binder with lined filler paper

**Geometry:** 3-ring binder with dividers, filler paper, graphing calculator\*

**History (All) & Government:** 3-ring binder with lined filler paper

**Journalism:** Notebook or lined paper for notes, colored pens, highlighters

**Meteorology:** 3-ring binder with dividers, filler paper, 1 spiral notebook, calculator

**Orchestra:** 1½" 3-ring binder, 5 dividers, Mute

**PE 1:** Notebook with pocket or a binder with filler paper, athletic shorts, plain t-shirt, and sneakers

**Photography:** Access to a 35mm SLR manual operational camera and access to a digital camera or camera phone, 1" binder

**Physics:** 1" 3-ring binder, 1 graph paper spiral for lab reports, two 1-subject spiral notebooks

**Precalculus, AP Calculus:** 3-ring binder with dividers, graphing calculator\*

**Principles of Engineering:** 3-ring binder with dividers, graphing calculator\*

**Sciences (All):** 3-ring binder with dividers, scientific or Nspire calculator\*

**Spanish 1 & 2:** 3-ring binder with 3 dividers, index cards

**Spanish 3 & 4:** 3-ring binder

**Chemistry:** Scientific calculator with trig/log functions (TI-30, TI-34, Casio 260 or 300, Sharp 506 or 520)

**Algebra, AP Calculus, Discrete Math, Geometry CP 1 & 2, Honors Precalculus, Physics, Precalculus, and Principles of Engineering:**

TI-Nspire CX CAS is required and must be purchased and charged before school begins. "CAS" must appear on the upper right part of the calculator.
