NOTE: Rates above are per child. For example, if a family enrolls two children, one in grade 6 and another in grade 9, their total annual tuition rate would be \$12,750 (grade 6) + \$14,150 (grade 9) = \$26,900

- A non-refundable \$100 per family Application Fee and \$50 per child Student Testing Fee will be payable upon submission of completed Online Applications.
- A non-refundable \$350 per family Enrollment Fee will be payable upon submission of the Online Enrollment information for the first student in each family. The \$350 enrollment deposit will be applied to the September 1st family tuition statement.
- An annual Facility/Technology Fee of \$350 per family is payable in addition to tuition.
- Tuition is due by the 1st of each month in ten equal installments, September – June. **A late fee of \$25.00** will be assessed monthly on accounts that are past due.
- A **discount of 2%** of the Family Tuition Total will be given if full payment is received by **August 6, 2021**.
- Tuition assistance is available and must be applied for through Covenant Tuition Services (cts-tuition.com). Please inquire about our Tuition Assistance Program.

WCS WITHDRAWAL POLICY

WCS carefully plans for anticipated enrollment and is obligated to meet costs it cannot cancel due to student withdrawals. Any student who withdraws for any reason will be responsible for payment of their tuition and fee obligation based upon their date of withdrawal:

<u>Date of Withdrawal</u>	<u>Amount Due to WCS</u>
July 1 - Day before first day of school	25% of annual tuition and fees
First Day of School - December 15	50% of annual tuition and fees
After December 15	100% of annual tuition and fees
